



### Search for the Next *AIChE Journal* Editor

The *AIChE Journal* is the premier research monthly in chemical engineering and related fields, and is an official publication of the American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) that is published by John Wiley & Sons. With an editorial team of one editor, eight associate editors and 35 consulting editors, this peer-reviewed and broad-based journal reports on the most important and latest technological advances in core areas of chemical engineering and, reflecting the progressive outlook of the profession, in other emerging areas of research.

The editor is responsible for the overall quality of the *Journal*, oversees the peer review process, and will be expected to develop and implement strategies to enhance the reputation of the *Journal*. The editor selects the editorial team and staff. There is financial assistance from AIChE to support the staff. The editorial position is a five-year commitment, potentially renewable for an additional five years. The editor reports to the Publication Committee of AIChE and must abide by its ethical guidelines.

The Search Committee seeks an editor for *AIChE Journal* who:

- 1) sets high technical and ethical standards
- 2) has international stature and visibility
- 3) has a broad perspective on chemical engineering and related fields
- 4) is an effective communicator using various modern platforms of communication
- 5) presents and executes a strategic vision for the future of the *Journal*
- 6) embodies the [IDEAL](#) values of AIChE

*Note: Editorial experience is preferred but not required.*

Interested candidates should submit a letter of interest to the Search Committee by email to Michelle Bryner at [michelleb@aiiche.org](mailto:michelleb@aiiche.org), in pdf format, by May 24, and include: a statement (500 words maximum) describing your qualifications and broad vision for the *Journal*, a resume (three-page maximum), and a list of three references the committee can contact. Additional information will be requested from candidates selected as finalists for the editor position.

Finalist candidates will be asked to expand on their broad vision for the *Journal* and to comment specifically on:

- 1) Your aspirational goals for the *Journal* and the steps you will take to achieve them. How would those goals encompass the notion that the *Journal* is a home for traditional core areas, yet needs to continue to evolve toward emerging and interdisciplinary areas?
- 2) How you would take advantage of modern media platforms and other new information technology to promote and enhance the *Journal*
- 3) The steps you would take to increase and broaden the visibility, reach, and impact of the *Journal*
- 4) How the *Journal* and its editorial team, working with AIChE and Wiley, can maintain attractive metrics for time-to-decision and time-to-publication
- 5) How you would ensure equity, diversity, and inclusion among staff, reviewers, and authors
